# OPEN CALL

**for European Pancreatic Club (EPC) representative  
in the Scientific Committee of the United European Gastroenterology (UEG)**

## MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS - ELIGIBILITY

- The applicant needs to be member of the EPC when the application is submitted
- The applicant needs to be member of the EPC for at least 5 years
- Good command of spoken and written English
- Personal commitment and adequate time resources for volunteer work
- The applicant has to be internationally recognized scientist
- The applicant needs to have at least 10 original/review papers in distinguished international journals (listed in PubMed) in the field of gastroenterology/pancreatology
- The applicant has to represent EPC at the UEG Scientific Committee
- The applicant needs to make contact with the secretary before the EPC General Assembly meeting in order to discuss the interests of EPC
- The applicant has to attend all of UEG Scientific Committee meetings
- The applicant needs to declare that he fully accepts the UEG Committee Guidelines available on the webpage of UEG and EPC.

## TERMS OF OFFICE

- EPC representative in the UEG Scientific Committee will be elected for 4 years (from January 2018 – until December 2022)
- Second term is not possible

## SUBMITTING APPLICATIONS

The application has to be addressed to the Secretary of the EPC and must be written in English.

The applications must include:

- completed application form (can be downloaded from <http://e-p-c.org/open-calls>)
- CV (maximum of 3 pages, the CV has to contain the applicants total impact factor, number of citations and Hirsch index) and list of main publications (full articles only)
- Mission statement (maximum of 1 page)

Applications will be filed and tagged by the Secretary of the EPC. Should the application prove deficient, the Applicant shall be notified by e-mail within five working days. The Applicant should then eliminate the deficiency revealed within another five working days.

Submission deadline for the application: 10<sup>th</sup> October, 2016

Decision will be made by the EPC Council during the forthcoming council meeting in Vienna.
